Dear Parents:

The United Student League will celebrate **J.W. North's 54th Homecoming** with this year's theme, "**Huskies in Hyperspace ~ Shake Your Glow Thing!**" Student leaders are excited to present the **Homecoming Dance in North's Outdoor Gymnasium Courtyard** on **Saturday, September 29** from **7:00 p.m. – 11:00 p.m.** A **Food Festival** will be held before the dance from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. in the **Arcade**. Free vendor foods will be included in the price of the dance ticket. Guests are encouraged to arrive early to enjoy dinner before the dance starts. Homecoming finalists will be announced at 9:00 p.m. Tickets will be sold on a first come, first served basis **September 10 – September 28**. All North students and their pre-approved off-campus guests are invited to attend. All pre-approved guests must be currently enrolled in high school and receive permission from their school to attend. Students who have been expelled or are currently enrolled in a program for expelled students will not be allowed to attend the Homecoming Dance.

Over the past few years, there has been a concern among high school administrators regarding the style of dancing at school dances. It is the school's position that students follow school rules and behave in an appropriate manner when attending a school activity. Sexually explicit behavior and/or dancing will not be tolerated at J.W. North High School dances. Students and their guests who choose to act in an inappropriate manner will be asked to leave the dance and may be subject to further disciplinary consequences. Parents will be notified. Refunds will not be given.

School dances have traditionally been positive activities that encourage the involvement of all students. Please note that Riverside Unified School District drug and alcohol policies are strictly enforced. In order to continue this tradition and in an effort to provide a safe environment for all, I ask that you discuss the dance policy and attached dance guidelines with your student. Parent support of this policy is crucial. Please understand that warnings will not be given at the dance. In the event of disciplinary action at the Homecoming Dance, students may not be eligible to participate in future North High School activities such as the Midwinter Ball, Prom, Grad Nite, etc. Seniors, especially, should be mindful of the expectations of the Senior Behavior Contract to be handed out and discussed in September.

Before tickets may be purchased, students and parents are asked to sign below to verify that information in this letter and dance guidelines have been read and understood. North students are responsible for the behavior of their off-campus guests, as well. **Off-campus guests must submit an Off-Campus Guest Application and do not need to sign below.**
